**PURPOSE**

This Scholarship Program is designed to:

1. Promote interest in the construction industry by assisting young people to achieve a higher level of education in the industry or a field directly related to it.

**GENERAL POLICIES**

1. The scholarship program shall be supported entirely through voluntary contributions and/or funds raised by the members of the Columbia Chapter #113. Funds designated for scholarships shall be placed in the General Operating Fund of the Chapter and designated for Scholarship Fund, and administered by the Scholarship Committee and the Chapter Board of Directors.
2. The Scholarship Program shall be promoted by Columbia Chapter #113 members at the High School and College levels.
3. The recipients shall be selected from applicants obtained through the high schools, colleges, universities, trade schools, or technical schools in South Carolina. The recipient must attend a college, university or technical school in South Carolina. (Exception: If applying for Rose Parrish Scholarship recipient must attend the University of South Carolina.) Each applicant must submit a fully completed application as furnished by the Chapter, copy attached. Final selections shall be made by the Scholarship Committee. (Incomplete application will invalidate it.)
  - a. The application may be made by hard copy to NAWIC, Attn. Scholarship Chair, Post Office Box 7531, Columbia, SC 29202-7531 OR sent on-line directly to the Scholarship Chair.
4. The scholarship recipient, ONCE APPROVED, shall be notified in writing with appropriate details of his/her scholarship. All Applicant's scholarships will be acknowledged. Those not awarded will be kept on file for one year.
5. The amount of each scholarship shall be determined by the Scholarship Committee by available funds. The check will be made payable to the scholarship recipient.
6. The scholarship shall be continued provided the student maintains at least an overall 2.850 GPA average in all subjects chosen for study. GRADES are to be furnished immediately to the Scholarship Committee upon receipt, and within 30 days of the completion of a semester, or the student will not be considered for the following semester. Prior to award of additional funds, the recipient must submit certification from his/her Advisor of the next semester class schedule and any changes in their major.
7. Should the recipient transfer to a field not related to the scholarship guidelines, the scholarship shall be discontinued.
8. The deadline for application shall be May 1 for the first semester and November 1 for the second semester.
